 - o If you print ICC reports and or check the box that you're going to register later, which means you have to pay for the registration sooner and they are definitely not backing down.
 - But they are going to try to maybe realign the point at which the rating credit would come out of the providers credits.
 - The bigger work that they're going to do is to try to help make it more manageable for providers to be able to track it, because there's currently no tracking mechanism for it.

- Cindy- How can broaden our scope of Board members? How to plant seed? Start on committees?
- Include membership slide for webinars, maybe also board.
- Energy around mentorship pilot may draw new organizational members and new board members.
 - o Still need change in bylaws to allow different configuration of seats, while retain working board.
- Concerns with software recertification credits for HERS Rating Credentials. Sharla's got something for
 it. New plans and take offs, but can't use Bluebeam and Sketch-Up. Posed question to Scott about
 developing curriculum like modeler light. Came up about doing something at GDS. Training committee,
 maybe NEHERS can offer on demand. Once per quarter. Another option for credits.
 - Ben Graham- EnergyLogic- Invite to Training Committee. Share copy of manual with NDA. Has some free time, might help fill gaps.
- Last QAD meeting RESNET trying to see what the requirements will be for raters and modelers CEU specific to software that they use.
 - At first, needed curriculum approved by software providers, but software probiders push back, not want it.
 - Requirement is that for each cycle for certification the rater/modeler would need 3 credits for software that they are using.
 - PSD includes it in their webinars, with CEUs.
 - Similarly could do NEHERS. Some people are taking modeler course to get these credits, modeler course is very comprehensive, test is model is secure. Complex logistics for the test.
 - Easier to incorporate with regular CEU cycles. Need 3 hours of CEUs based on software. Ask Scott how apply for RESNET Credits. Provider tracks that.
