# ENERGY CODES (Michael R.)

- The Energy Codes Committee met for our quarterly meeting on April 8th
- Massachusetts recently updated their stretch code on February 14<sup>th</sup>, and the updated technical guidance and additional guidance for embodied carbon calculations in Massachusetts from DOER is expected in the next few weeks, and the updated Mass Save tools will also be available soon.
- There's been a lot of questions and education around the new Embodied Carbon provisions.
- The 2027 IECC Consensus Committees have been beginning to meet to discuss code change proposals.
- No draft yet of the 2027.
- Maine's updated Energy Code with the 2021 IECC took effect on April 7<sup>th</sup> 2025, and can be found <u>here</u>.

#### EMBODIED CARBON (Joel)

  - The final report is now being written by NMR.
